About the Dutch Input List

The Dutch Input List is a public online register of inputs that may be used by certified organic farmers in The Netherlands. It is produced in co-operation by Skäl and FiBL. The Dutch Input List was first published in 2016 and was originally restricted to inputs for crop production, i.e. fertilisers, soil conditioners, plant protection products and related materials. From 2022 on, the Dutch Input List will also contain feed materials and silage additives of non-agricultural origin. The schedule for the inclusion of feed materials is as follows:

From February 2022 onwards	Submission of dossiers for evaluation
From summer 2022 onwards	Compliant products included in the Dutch Input List
