General information

There are a multitude of products with different uses and modes of action. However, there are only **three types of application forms** available. The paragraphs below will help you to determine which form shall be used for your product(s). The forms are regularly updated. **Please use always the most recent version**.

For assistance with filling in the application forms, please consult the document "**How to submit a product**", provided on the Dutch Input List website.

The fertilizer application form shall be used for:

- all products categorised as fertilisers under EU or national legislation
- all products intended to improve the performance of crops or the soil
- plant nutrients (primary, secondary and micro-nutrients)
- soil <u>conditioners</u>, soil <u>additives</u>, soil <u>inoculants</u>, <u>stone meals</u> etc.
- plant strengtheners, plant aids, biodynamic and homeopathic preparations etc.
- fertiliser and compost <u>additives</u>
- mulching materials and other technical materials,
- seed coatings, sowing aids etc.

The potting soil application form shall be used for:

pre-packed potting soils

The plant protection application form shall be used for:

- all products categorised as plant protection products
- all products containing <u>active or basic substances</u> approved under EU legislation
- all products for <u>use against a specific plant disease or pest</u>
- <u>beneficial organisms</u> with a specific action against plant diseases or pests
- products for attracting, repelling or trapping pests
- pruning agents and wound protectants

<u>Please note:</u> Products for <u>disinfection</u>, <u>cleaning & hygiene</u>, <u>feed/feed additives</u>, products for <u>parasite control</u> as well as products for <u>food processing</u> are currently **not in scope of the Dutch Input List**. Hence no evaluation of such products is offered at the moment. Any extension of scope will be announced on the Dutch Input List website.
